Letter from the

Chair and President

35 Years and Counting

We have built a monster. Over the last 35 years, the North Dakota Community Foundation has worked to be all things philanthropic to the citizens of North Dakota. We have democratized and de-mystified philanthropy for those who want to give back to and for the benefit of North Dakotans. Some people in business try to mystify their work so that the person on the street feels that they need help and will pay for that "expertise". We have taken the opposite tack and worked to make our activities transparent, effective and easily understood by all those who work with us.

It's difficult to convey the breadth and depth of our connection to the communities of North Dakota. You can get a sense of our reach if you visit our website and click on the map, choose a community and see all of our interactions with just that one community. There are very few points on the North Dakota map where you can click and not find a connection to one of our component funds, grants made, a scholarship fund, a board member or some other type of interaction.

This level of connection did not happen by accident. NDCF staff have traveled over 1,250,000 miles in the last 35 years visiting those communities on the map. We have conducted much of our business faceto-face with donors, community leaders, volunteers and others interested in our work. We have attended meetings at 7a.m., 7 p.m., Saturday morning, Sunday night or whatever works best for the donor, local volunteer, service club or whomever has wanted to see us.

The Foundation's main business is to build a permanent endowment for the future of North Dakota. That said, the Foundation has stepped up to assist in other ways than just building endowment. Just last summer we were asked by Governor Jack Dalrymple to establish a state-wide flood relief fund to help relief and recovery efforts across ND. That effort resulted in over \$1.3 million in grants to help those affected by 2011's flood events. We did a similar service in the Red River Valley flood of 1997. These are just two examples of "projects" that we have been called upon to help make happen, efficiently, effectively and professionally without the need to start a new organization. Accomplish the mission, move on to the next.

Established with a gift from the family of Claire and Evelyn Hermes, long-time Fairmount residents. The Fairmount Community Endowment Fund provides a method of receiving funds/donations to benefit projects in the Fairmount area

Established to raise monies to improve this important recreational facility in Eddy County.

Garrison Area Community Foundation

Established by the Better Living For Garrison organization with an initial gift from Wayne Stroup. The Garrison Area Community Foundation is a permanent endowment for the future of the Garrison community. Annual grants from the Garrison Area Community Foundation will be used to meet the changing needs of the community.

Bremer Opportunity Fund

The Bremer Opportunity Fund is a \$1,000,000 challenge grant to the North Dakota Community Foundation and the citizens of Morton and



Burleigh counties to build a permanent flexible financial resource for the future of the community.

Brian Meehl Memorial Scholarship Fund

Established in memory of Brian Meehl to assist students from Oakes High School to continue their education. Brian was raised in Oakes graduating HS in 1977. He later attended UND where he was a member of the Sigma Alpha Epsilon Fraternity. He graduated in December 1982 with a degree in Parks and Recreation.

Brian spent much of his adult life in Colorado. He loved the mountains, hunting, fishing and camping. In November, 2002 he made his ultimate climb in Quito, Ecuador where he climbed the highest peak in the Andes, Mt. Chimboroza (20,577ft).

Education was very important to Brian. After moving to Colorado he completed his Para-Legal degree, then went on to receive a business degree and at the time of his death was working toward an MBA. Brian died suddenly of a heart attack on October 26, 2008.

Audrey Doyle Scholarship Fund

Audrey Doyle Durand Barnes was a "card carrying member" of "The Greatest Generation"; she embodied all the attributes that define, quite simply, a good person and caring human being.

Her father died when she was only 4 years old leaving her and three siblings to be raised by a single mom in the midst of the depression. After graduating from high school Audrey knew first hand what it like to have no funding for higher education and entered into the workforce. She was blessed with two marriages, each lasting over 25 years, and helped raised and nurture three children, three stepchildren, grandchildren and great grandchildren, as well as many nieces and nephews.

Her work ethic was impeccable, her commitment to what was fair and right was without question. She not only belonged to many organizations, she was a contributing member of society; a member of the company union, Business and Professional Women's Club (ND State President in 1974), American Legion Axillary, Homemakers groups, Centennial Celebrations, Girl Scout Leader and cheerleader for every child that came into her world and every cause she felt worthy.

Motivation

Thinking back on your own experience, what motivated you to make the leap to become a donor? Was it pure charitable intent, the chance to increase your income, tax avoidance or some combination of these factors?

The desire to "Leave a Legacy" is usually the main, and strongest, motivation behind any donation. There are many ways you could shelter your wealth, so without some level of charitable intent, you probably would not have made a gift to charity. Whether you were remembering someone with a memorial gift, making an unrestricted gift to your community or helping a student continue their education, the chance to see that gift in action and what it can do for the intended recipient was a powerful incentive. It is human nature to want to leave a mark on this world the short time we are here. Your choice to do that with a gift to a charity was an excellent way to make a difference for generations to come.

For some donors, a gift to charity is a way to increase and/or stabilize current income. A few years ago, a gentleman from the Grafton area wanted to leave a gift to the Grafton Community Endowment Fund, but also receive an income from that gift. He chose to enter into a *Charitable Gift Annuity* with the Fund. In this way, he received income from the gift for the rest of his life (with a rate based solely on his age) and upon his passing, the community received a wonderful gift that will continue to benefit the entire area into perpetuity. With current interest rates at historic lows, this may be an avenue you want to explore.

Perhaps tax advantages are what drew you to first look into charitable giving. Since 2007, when the North Dakota Legislature first enacted tax credits for certain gifts to charity, donors have had an added incentive to give. For example, a donor who has been giving to the North Dakota Community Foundation for years, used these tax credits to increase his gift from his usual \$1,000 per year donation to \$5,000. The newly added benefit to individuals allowed him to increase his gift with very little "cost" to him.

Every individual has their own reasons why they choose to give to a charity. In reality, it is probably some combination of all these factors, and even others not considered here. But regardless of any of the financial benefits to making a charitable gift, it still comes back to charitable intent. The one thing that every donor I have ever encountered has in common is the desire to do something good for future generations. The unselfish, heart-felt generosity of donors I have the distinct honor to witness each and every day is what makes this job the greatest there is!

Building Solid Relationships

When I tell people that I help communities in western North Dakota build charitable resources, they often assume that it's an easy job. "There's a ton of money in oil country! You must be swamped with donations." They incorrectly assume that just because the money is there, nonprofits have easy access to a steady stream of large donations. While it's true that several of our Community Endowment Funds have seen large donations from residents who are benefiting from the oil boom, it hasn't been an easy task. Many still remember the oil boom and bust of the 1980s, causing them to proceed with extreme caution when making significant financial decisions. No matter how much money is out there, we still rely on the tried and true fundraising technique of building relationships. This method takes time and patience, and the results are not always immediate.

Over the last 35 years and throughout the entire state, staff from the Foundation have built the trust and respect of community and business leaders; professionals such as attorneys, bankers, accountants, and financial planners; economic development groups; citizens; and, of course, donors. We talk about the history of the Foundation, how we came to be, our mission, and the work we do in communities across the state. We share information about our financial health, how our endowment has grown over the years. We share stories about the good times and the bad. Through these open and honest conversations, we build the strong relationships which lead to long-term support of the Foundation and our component funds.

For example, in the spring of 2011, the Foundation received a call from a landowner in the Stanley area who wanted to donate 10 acres of his land to the Stanley Area Community Foundation. The donor received an immediate tax deduction for the current value of the land, avoided capital gains, and made a significant

contribution to the Stanley endowment fund. The gift also qualified for the North Dakota charitable income tax credit. The donor had not been previously identified by the committee members as a potential donor, but because of the Foundation's relationships with local professionals, the donor was able to identify the Foundation as a vehicle for meeting his charitable giving and financial goals.

The community of Stanley also serves as a wonderful example of how Advisory Committee members can use their existing relationships with members of the community to build endowment and encourage gifts to other projects and organizations. In 2011, the Advisory Committee raised \$64,200 for the endowment fund, and collected \$10,000 in donations designated to other entities, such as the ambulance service, city park, library, fire department, and aquatic center. All of this was possible because committee members possessed strong relationships with their fellow community members, which they had gained over the years prior to their involvement with the Foundation. Alone, Foundation staff members would not have had the success of the volunteers who live and work in their communities, who have earned the trust and respect of their neighbors.

Even in a booming economic climate, successful fundraising requires that we make the time and effort to build solid relationships with those who can help support our mission.

Mission Statement

The mission of the North Dakota Community Foundation is to improve the quality of life for North Dakota's citizens through charitable giving and promoting philanthropy.

About the North Dakota Community Foundation

The North Dakota Community Foundation was incorporated in October of 1976 and began full operations on January 1, 1977. NDCF is an IRS designated 501(c) (3) statewide public nonprofit tax-exempt corporation that receives and distributes charitable funds to support a wide range of programs that benefit North Dakotans.

NDCF was formed by a group of concerned citizens who were looking for a general charitable vehicle to build endowment to support the nonprofit sector in the State. Initial support for the Foundation came from the Otto Bremer Foundation, the Northwest Area Foundation, the Northwest Bancorporation, the North Dakota Bremer Banks and the Bush Foundation.

The office staff under the supervision of its volunteer Board of Directors carries out the work of the Foundation. Board members represent all citizens of North Dakota. All grant distribution decisions are made by the NDCF Board of Directors.


Meeting Operating Expenses

Giving to the Foundation

Outright gifts, including gifts of appreciated property, stocks, closely held stock, cash and real estate, are accepted by the North Dakota Community Foundation. The Foundation also provides full service deferred giving. We offer charitable gift annuities, charitable remainder trusts, charitable lead trusts, bequests and the full gamut of deferred tax-wise gifts. Of course, all gifts to the Foundation are fully tax deductible and may be eligible for North Dakota income tax credits. Please consult your tax advisor for the current limits. Your gift can be used in any number of ways, including:

Named Fund – Become a partner with the Foundation with a named Unrestricted Fund that addresses the diverse and changing needs in our state.

Field of Interest Fund – Select a focus area where grants from your fund will be used to address changing needs.

Donor Advised Fund – Be a donor advisor and recommend how your fund can address the needs you find most important.

Scholarship Fund – Grants from your scholarship fund can assist students to further their education. Students can be chosen based on criteria you recommend.

Community Endowment Fund – Donations build a permanent flexible financial resource for your community. Grant decisions are made by a local volunteer advisory committee and are given to deserving local causes.

2011 Auditor's Report

The NDCF Board of Directors engaged an independent certified public accounting firm to audit the Foundation's modified cash basis financial statements for the year ended December 31, 2011. The auditors have issued an unqualified opinion dated February 15, 2012, on the modified cash basis financial statements presented. Copies of the audit are on file at the Foundation's office for inspection.

NEW TAX CREDIT

The 2011 ND Legislature passed and Governor Dalrymple signed SB 2160 which offers new tax credits for gifts to qualified North Dakota Endowment Funds. This law enhances existing law which already allowed a 40% ND income tax credit for businesses which give to qualified ND Endowment Funds and also a ND income tax credit for individuals who establish a qualified deferred gift with a ND charitable organization.


SB 2160 enhances existing law by including financial institutions which were inadvertently left out of the original legislation. Since financial institutions have their own section in the ND Century Code, they are unique and need to be addressed specifically. SB 2160 allows ND financial institutions the same ND income tax credit as other businesses.

Also included in the new law is a provision that allows a ND income tax credit of 40% of the gift up to a \$10,000 credit per taxpayer for gifts by individuals to qualified ND endowment funds. The individual must give at least \$5,000 in a tax year to a single endowment fund in order to qualify for the credit.

Your gift of \$5,000 to one of the NDCF's qualified endowment funds is not only tax deductible on your federal income tax return, it should also qualify for a 40% or \$2,000 credit against your ND income tax liability. If you are in the 30% federal income tax bracket, the net cost of your \$5,000 gift could be as low as \$1,500 after taking the federal and ND income tax benefits into account. If you cannot use all of your ND income tax credit in one year, you may carry it forward for an additional 3 years.

As the above illustrates, this new law creates wonderful incentives for North Dakota taxpayers to give back to qualified ND charitable endowment funds. Please contact us to discuss how you can work with the NDCF to carry out your charitable dreams and benefit from this fantastic tax incentive.

Grant Application Guidelines

The North Dakota Community Foundation serves North Dakota communities statewide with the goal of improving the quality of life for the state's citizens. Applications for a grant from community endowment funds are available from the local advisory committees. The Foundation administers many different types of funds. Most of the funds are restricted to a specific purpose. These guidelines deal with the Foundation's Unrestricted Grants.

Grant seekers should note the following before contacting NDCF concerning a grant:

- 1. NDCF makes grants only to those organizations designated by the IRS Code as 501(c)(3) nonprofit tax-exempt groups or government agencies. Before writing a letter proposal to NDCF seeking financial assistance, please make certain that your organization is eligible for a grant according to the stated tax-exempt requirement.
- 2. Please submit a concise letter proposal not to exceed two (2) pages describing the organization, the project, the approximate project cost and the amount to be requested from NDCF only one request per agency per year. Since NDCF serves organizations statewide, grants normally do not exceed \$5,000. These letter proposals must be received by NDCF no later than August 15. NDCF does not accept fax or email letter requests.

- 3. The NDCF Directors review the letter requests in September. If the Board is interested in additional information, formal application materials are sent. If you do not receive an application by October 1, you will know that the Board has not chosen your project for consideration.
- 4. Grants are paid out in the late fall.
